

THE GARDENER DVD SETS

Garden Makeover, Disk 1 (1:06:20)

- 1) Laying paving, making pathways and building a water feature.
- 2) Laying circle paving and erecting a Trimstyle™ pergola.
- 3) Gardening in the shade under trees, laying paving, putting in a bench and putting up bamboo screening.
- 4) Japanese/Zen garden with rocks and white gravel.
- 5) Entrance makeover – painting, tiling, placing pots and planting.

Garden Makeover, Disk 2 (1:07:25)

- 1) Creating a structured garden bed, slate pillars and coble edging.
- 2) Restructuring an entrance garden, pruning topiaries and controlling snails.
- 3) Building low garden bed walls, putting up trellis panels and planting up the bed.
- 4) Laying a pathway with wooden poles and gravel.
- 5) Courtyard makeover using water features, trellis, painting and planting a bed.

Garden Makeover, Disk 3 (1:14:22)

- 1) Using paving, pots and creating garden beds.
- 2) Building Loffelstein™ walls and what plants to plant in them.
- 3) Working with large walls using trellises, pedestals and urns with aloes in them.
- 4) Small garden makeover – creating interest in beds with edgings and pots.
- 5) Creating a garden room with paving, tables and chairs and interesting plants.
- 6) Garden bed makeover using grasses, trellis, pots and aloes.

Water Features, Disk 1 (1:04:47)

- 1) Building a plastic lined pond with rocks and putting in an interesting selection of plants.
- 2) Making a pot water feature accentuated with trellising.
- 3) Building a sandstone water feature with a steel trellis.
- 4) A traditional water feature in a pond, with lighting, finished off with an array of white plants.
- 5) Assembling a cascading grotto falls with a mist maker and selection of plants.

Water Features, Disk 2 (39:24)

- 1) Building a slate water feature, planting screening trees and filler plants.
- 2) Taking a look at larger water features and waterfalls, some garden ideas, installing a small stone water feature and planting aloes and ground covers.

Containers, Disk 1 (40:00)

- 1) Talking a look at different pots, plant combinations and steps to take when planting pots.
- 2) Hanging baskets – take a look at different options, plus what you need and how to plant up a hanging basket.
- 3) Potted herbs – herb combinations and recipes.
- 4) Alternate containers: creating an alpine garden, planting in an old wheelbarrow and making your own slate planter box.
- 5) Patio Garden – create a garden using pots and containers.

Containers, Disk 2 (39:02)

- 1) Creating a raised planter box from old discarded wooden pallets.
- 2) Roof top gardening, gardening in difficult conditions and using containers smartly.
- 3) Tips on keeping containers looking their best, plus tricks to planting very large pots.
- 4) Transforming old boring pots into something new and exciting.

- 1) Looking at succulent gardening and how to propagate succulents.
- 2) Looking at how plants are grown from seed and how you can germinate your own seeds.
- 3) Growing plants in rocky walls.
- 4) Growing plants in bad conditions, propagating plants from cuttings and making hanging wall features with succulents.
